

BAKER ACT – MARCHMAN ACT

RESEARCH GUIDE

OVERVIEW

Baker Act – is a means of providing individuals with emergency services and temporary detention for mental health evaluation and treatment when required (often referred to as an Ex Parte Order).

Stewart-Marchman Act – Florida’s Substance Abuse Impairment Act provides assistance to individuals in need of emergency services and temporary detention due to substance abuse.
